JUNIOR SQUAD CONTRACT

As a member of Parsippany Volunteer Ambulance Junior Squad, your role is to aide the senior squad and educate yourself such that you may serve as an integral member of the senior squad when the time comes. These are the responsibilities that you agree to take on when joining the Junior Squad:

- Respect patient confidentiality
- Ride a minimum of 4 hours a week
- Attend meetings and drills monthly
- Attend squad functions
- Notify Captain of any schedule changes
- Hand in letter if unable to attend meeting or drill
- Find coverage and notify Lieutenant of Crew Chief when not riding

If these responsibilities are not met at any time, a Senior member or fellow Junior member may write up a warning. This warning will be given to the Junior Squad advisor and will be put in the Junior member's file. After having accumulated 2 warnings, the Junior member will be placed back on probation for a period of time to be decided by the Junior Squad advisors and officers. If, during this probationary period, the Junior member receives another warning, the Junior member can have an extended period of probation, or can be suspended from Parsippany Volunteer Ambulance Squad.
